#SouthSudan #Peacehackcamp is an inter-communal peace-building project aimed at media literacy training and networking with people from all cultural and socio-economic backgrounds, literacy levels, including those with informal education, self-taught skills and people displaced by conflict. Initiated by a group of dedicated South Sudanese students, IT and media professionals, **#Peacehackcamp** will address how to make and share media, not just consume it, while introducing and creating public awareness on the benefits Open ICTs, Innovation and Open Educational Resources (OERs) as vehicles for peacebuilding, development and national reconciliation

The **#Peacehackcamp** is a project by **Kapital Movie Industry Corporation (KMIC)**, Juba, South Sudan, a community interest based, non-profit corporation. It was formed in 2011 as a network of visionary youths committed to empowering the communities they live, work and study in through the power of media, ICT and open expression. The organization is concerned with conflict mitigation, media literacy, and the development of peaceful methods of association to help cement the process of nation building, and community development.

The **#Peacehackcamp** programme presented by **Kapital Movie / jHUB**, at **Central Equatoria Women's Union** and the **Aggrey Jaden Cultural Center** in Juba will include a broad programme of themes and formats ... from talks and innovation showcases to barcamps, concerts, hands-on workshops and a peacebuilder app code-a-thon ... from community mapping to DIY hardware making ... exploring ICTs and Open Knowledge resources from Wikipedia, to Scratch coding, to Raspberry Pi computing, to guerilla gardening, to up-cycling innovation, to combating social media hate speech ... and much more ...

The **#Peacehackcamp** kicks off on Monday November 30th at Juba's Aggrey Jaden Cultural Center, with pre-event activities, music and hackidemics for kids on Sunday November 29th!
